CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Our aim is to design products with a long life cycle and to always use high quality materials. When designing a product, we want to give it a purpose, a place in this world, a part in a bigger narrative. The worth of a product is not in the name of who designed it, but in the stories you share with it. By following these care instructions you will be able to share many great stories with your product for years to come.



Delivery

Most of our products are delivered ready assembled. Sometimes parts of a product can be packed separately to prevent transport damage. We always deliver your products properly wrapped. When getting your hands on the product, whether you bought it, stole it or got it as a gift, it can be a good idea to check that everything is in order. Some screws may need tightening, or cushions may need some puffing and shaping.

Some of our chairs and sofas are delivered with their legs packed separately. The products have pre-drilled holes in the base for the legs. Insert the leg and screw until it feels nice and tight. Never use too much force, as this can damage the attachment nut.

Always protect your furniture from dirt, chain saws, puppies and different types of liquids. Always clean up spills as soon as possible. We have learned that beer isn't that bad, but don't ever spill red wine on upholstered products. As for human beings, UV radiation can be quite bad for upholstery materials. UV radiation weakens the seams and fades the fabric. If you want your cool product to have a long life span, remember to protect it from direct sunlight.

Lacquered surfaces

Lacquered surfaces can be cleaned with a dry or slightly damp cloth. If necessary, you can use a mild environmentally friendly detergent. Wipe dry afterwards using a soft cloth. Always take care of any stains immediately. Don't use strong solvents or alcohol.

Compact laminate

Wipe with a dry or damp cloth in everyday cleaning. Compact laminate is quite durable and can withstand most cleaning chemicals and alcohol. We recommend trying a mild environmentally friendly detergent first. Wipe dry afterwards using a soft cloth.

Wood

Wood can be cleaned with a dry or slightly damp cloth in everyday cleaning. If necessary, you can use a mild environmentally friendly detergent. Wipe dry afterwards using a soft cloth. The shape of wood can shift over time, it's a living material. Wooden surfaces can be damaged by hot objects like cups or plates. Try keeping your wooden furniture away from radiators, flamethrowers and other heat sources.

Fabric

We use many different fabrics from various suppliers for our products. Always check the cleaning instructions for your particular fabric on the fabric supplier's website before cleaning your product. Vacuum the fabric in everyday cleaning. Always take care of any stains immediately. Use a cleaning product intended for textiles or warm water to get rid of stains. If you are about to use water and some kind of detergent, it is probably a good idea to test your cleaning combo on a small, less visible area of the fabric first. Avoid intense rubbing, because this may damage the fabric. You can also contact a professional cleaning company, they'll know what to do.

Leather

All leather needs regular care. We recommend dusting off the leather every now and then, since dirt can act as an abrasive on leather. Use a dry cloth in everyday cleaning. Use special leather cleaners to get rid of stains. Don't use strong detergents. Leather should be treated with leather protection a couple of times every year. Leather is a natural material and if treated right, it will become even cooler and more beautiful over the years.
